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AT A GLANCE

With enthusiasm and dedication, we are building a strong educational framework that will shape students' future

In April, the Bhavyata Foundation significantly impacted Igatpuri by aiding **280 bovines**, continuing its commitment to rural Maharashtra and urban Mumbai communities.

The Foundation's **adopted Anganwadis positively influence 500 children annually, providing early childhood education to 1389 underprivileged preschoolers in BMC schools in Mumbai.** Additionally, the Foundation supports **10 pregnant women monthly with essential nutritional kits.** Last year, the "**Plant a Caretaker**" project in Palghar district community unity saw empowering individuals to nurture moringa saplings for additional household income, encouraging the upcoming year of environmental stewardship.

Breed Preservation

In alignment with the sustainability principle, our goal is to guide villages toward economic self-sufficiency through agriculture & cottage industry, providing training in organic farming, breed preservation & the principles of good governance. Bhavyata Foundation is dedicated to reinforcing breed preservation for the betterment of India's dairy industry.



DANGI BREEDS SURVIVAL

SAMVARDHAN, through its 'Sowing the Seeds' initiative, aids gopalaks in preserving indigenous breeds amid challenges posed by limited grazing pastures and inadequate feed resources.



FEED DISTRIBUTION

Amidst the scorching summer heat and scarce resources, we've stepped in to support cows in need by distributing 0.8 tons of dry nutritional fodder.



GOPALAKS SUPPORTED

8 Gopalaks and 280 bovines benefitted, resulting in increased milk production after consuming nutritional feed. The Gopalaks then process the milk into condensed form sold in the marketplace, providing livelihoods.

Pregnant women in underprivileged communities face a lack of proper nutrition, healthcare, and support, which can lead to complications during pregnancy and childbirth. We thank **Inner Wheel Of Bombay Charity Trust & Meenakshi Pradhan** for their generosity. **On April 25, 2024**, we supported **10 expectant women** with nutritional kits and guidance at **Kamraj Nagar, Ghatkopar** in Mumbai.



COUNSELLING

Our team has conducted awareness campaigns and provided nutrition education to promote healthy eating habits among pregnant women. Newly Installed TV was greatly impactful as it served as an efficient medium of communication.



GARBH SANSKAR SESSION

We conducted Garbh Sanskar sessions for expecting mothers, using audio-visual tools and illustrations to provide knowledge on Garbh Samvad, nutritional guidance, and overall well-being.



GROCERY KIT DISTRIBUTION

The support has helped ensure that expectant mothers receive proper nutrition and emotional support during pregnancy. The nutrition kit (5 kg) includes **ingredients Wheat Flour(1kg), Jaggery(1kg), Moong dal(250gms), Black raisin(200gms), Almonds (200gms), Lal Chana (200gms) and Roasted Chana (250gms)**



ADOPT ANGANWADI

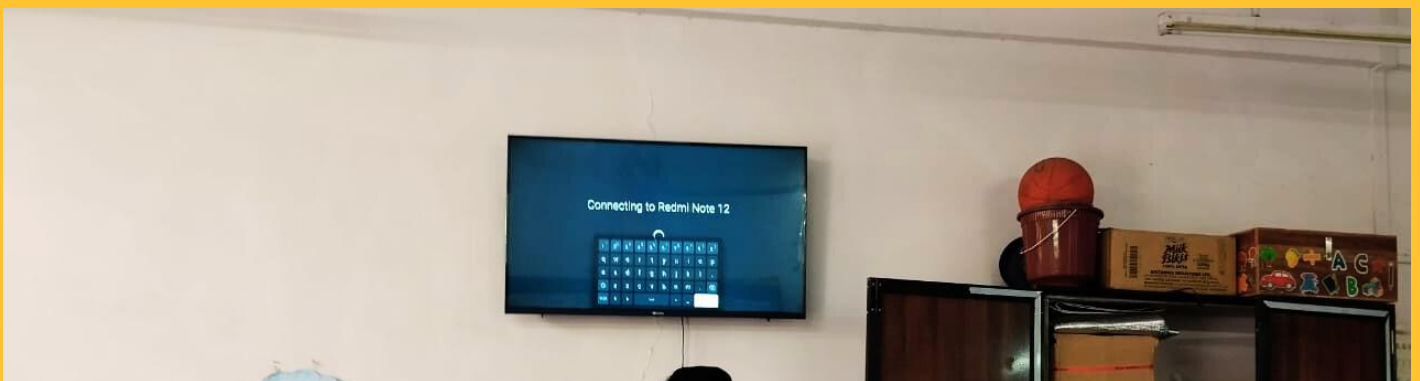
Empowering Preschool Education

EXAMS & OPEN DAY IN BALWADI SCHOOLS

Bhavyata Foundation organized an Open Day at **5 BMC Preschools** (Marathi Medium), where parents received report cards with areas for improvement and guidance on admission procedures for Class I. Alongside, parents were equipped with suggestions for fostering continued learning at home. At the same time, a survey near the schools identified potential additional students aged 3-6 years, totalling **77 (5-6 years) children for enrollment for class 1 in the upcoming academic year 2024-2025.**



LESSONS FOR LIFE OPEN DAY IN MPS SCHOOLS



Bhavyata Foundation organized an open day across 11 Mumbai Public Schools, providing parents of Marathi-medium preschool children with comprehensive report cards and guidance on admission procedures for Class I, alongside suggestions for at-home learning continuation. As part of its commitment to serving the underprivileged, the Foundation also conducted a survey of children aged 3-6 years, identifying a significant number for potential enrollment in the upcoming academic year 2024-2025.

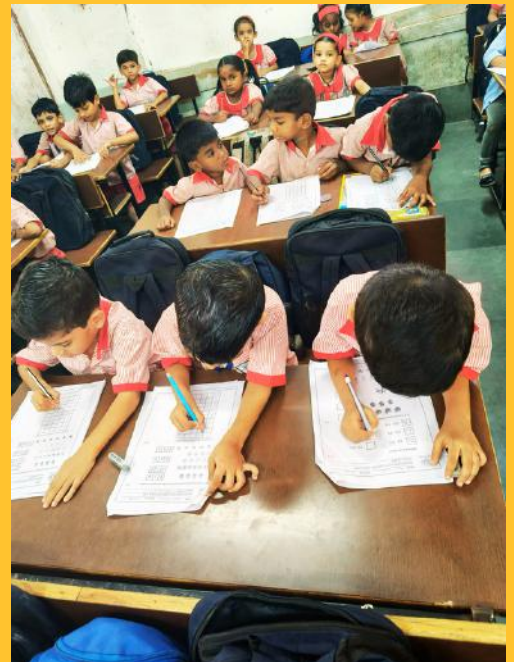

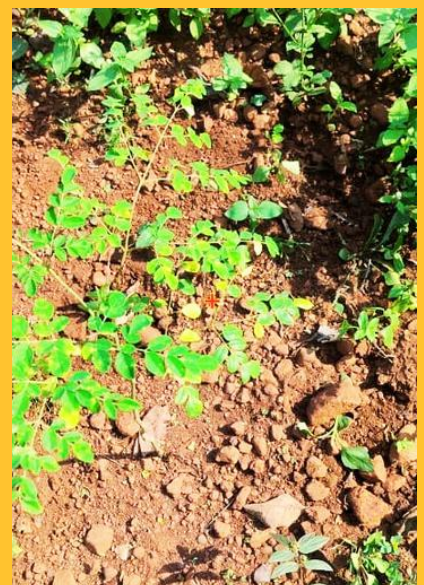

SCHOOL OF SUSTENANCE PLANT A CARETAKER

"Plant a caretaker" suggests nurturing someone responsible for caring for others or the environment. It's about fostering compassion and stewardship for a sustainable and equitable future. We donated **1000 Moringa saplings** to the farmers in the Wada belt facilitated by the **Keshav Shrushti gram vikas yojana**; the farmers who planted saw favourable sapling growth in less than a year and will nurture them further.

Around **50 farmers** benefitted from this cause.

The moringa plant will bear fruits, and selling these fruits brings additional income to rural households. Such a big project brings a sense of togetherness and unity to the community.
