We are dedicated to nurturing healthy and empowering childhood to the neediest and unprivileged children.



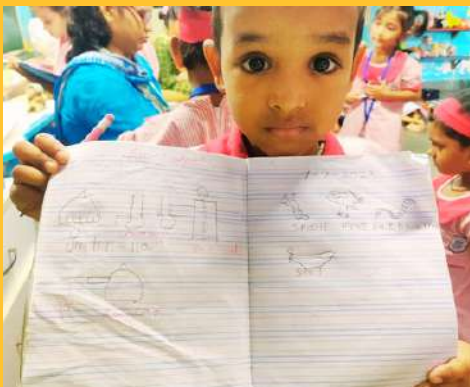

# SUTR SANTATI

Ikat weaving, also known as "ikkat" or "patola" weaving, is a traditional and intricate textile technique that involves dyeing the yarn before weaving it into a fabric. This results in distinct patterns and motifs that emerge as the threads are woven together. Patola sarees, cherished heirlooms from Gujarat, showcase traditional artisan skills. Crafting one is labour-intensive but yields a prized textile masterpiece.
