Minister for Women and Child Welfare, Mr Mangal Prabhat Lodha stated that, in order to build Anganwadis "with people's engagement," the state's Women and Child Development Department has implemented a "Adopt Anganwadi" strategy through CSR. Individuals/-families/groups/NGOs, Voluntary Organizations, Trusts, can also invest in improving deliverables. Additionally, entering into a MoU with the Government of Maharashtra, Bhavyata Foundation has recently adopted an additional 40 state run Anganwadis on 4th March 2023.

Samvardhan aims at preserving our indigenous breeds for ensuring the survival of unique and valuable animals and for maintaining biodiversity in our world. This can help to create economic incentives for farmers and others to maintain and propagate these breeds, thereby supporting their long-term survival. We provided 450 kgs of dry nutritional feed in the Nashik district of Maharashtra. 200 bovines and 15 Gopalaks were benefited in this cause.

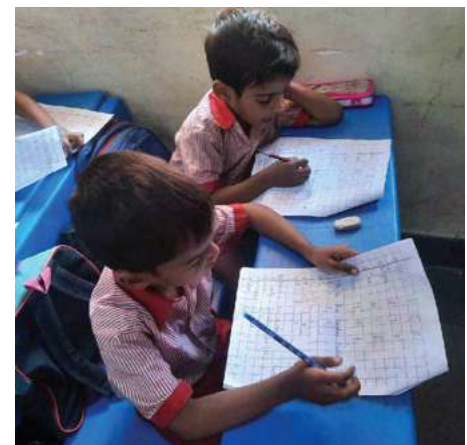
