IN SUMMARY

In May, Bhavyata Foundation supported 20 expectant mothers through the MAA program and provided feed for 280 livestock in Igatpuri during the extreme summer, fulfilling our commitment to community welfare. Our "Adopt an Anganwadi" projects in **Ghatkopar West are nearing** completion, creating a learning-enabled environment for underprivileged children. Concurrently, the Shrivan Wadi project aims to empower 10 tribal families by providing them with 400 saplings on 0.5 acres of land each, ensuring sustainable livelihoods with a minimum annual income of Rs. 50,00 per tribal family, thereby contributing to livelihoods, sustainability and combating climate change.

SAMVARDHAN Breed Preservation

In alignment with the sustainability principle, our goal is to guide villages toward economic self-sufficiency through agriculture & cottage industry, providing training in organic farming, breed preservation & the principles of good governance. Bhavyata Foundation is dedicated to reinforcing breed preservation for the betterment of India's dairy industry.



DANGI BREEDS SURVIVAL

SAMVARDHAN, through its 'Sowing the Seeds' initiative, aids gopalaks in preserving indigenous breeds amid challenges posed by limited grazing pastures and inadequate feed resources.



FEED DISTRIBUTION

Amidst the scorching summer heat and scarce resources, we've stepped in to support cows in need by distributing 0.8 tons of dry nutritional fodder.



GOPALAKS SUPPORTED

8 Gopalaks and 280 bovines benefitted, resulting in increased milk production after consuming nutritional feed. The Gopalaks then process the milk into condensed form sold in the marketplace, providing livelihoods.

Pregnant women in underprivileged communities face a lack of proper nutrition, healthcare, and support, which can lead to complications during pregnancy and childbirth. We thank **Inner Wheel** Of Bombay Charity Trust & Meenakshi Pradhan for their generosity. **On May 17, 2024**, we supported 20 **expectant women** with nutritional kits and quidance at **Kamraj Nagar**, Ghatkopar in Mumbai.



COUNSELLING

Our team has conducted awareness campaigns and provided nutrition education to promote healthy eating habits among pregnant women.

Newly Installed TV was greatly impactful as it served as an efficient medium of communication.



GARBH SANSKAR SESSION

We conducted Garbh Sanskar sessions for expecting mothers, using audio-visual tools and illustrations to provide knowledge on Garbh Samvad, nutritional guidance, and overall wellbeing.



GROCERY KIT DISTRIBUTION

The support has helped ensure that expectant mothers receive proper nutrition and emotional support during pregnancy. The nutrition kit (5 kg) includes **ingredients** Wheat Flour(1kg), Jaggery(1kg), Moong dal(250gms), Black raisin(200gms), Almonds (200gms), Lal Chana (200gms) and Roasted Chana (250gms).







ADOPT ANGANWADI Empowering Preschool Education

We're thrilled to announce our latest initiative, "Adopt Anganwadi," aimed at providing enhanced learning opportunities for underprivileged preschool children. We began our work on Anganwadi no. 134 at Jay Santoshi Mata SRA, Ghatkopar West, with wall paintings depicting educational themes in an interactive format.

This Anganwadi had been operated in various slum homes for 34 years, struggling to provide a stable environment for the children. The transformation into a lavishly facilitated SRA Anganwadi is a dream come true for the community.

LESSONS FOR LIFE ADOPT AN ANGANWADI INITIATIVE - GHATKOPAR WEST

The Bhavyata Foundation, Mumbai, has partnered with the Government of Maharashtra to implement the "Adopt an Anganwadi" initiative, adopting 48 Anganwadis across Mumbai and Rural Maharashtra for three years. Aimed at enhancing productivity through nutrition and experiential learning for children aged 3-6, this project involves complete operational, infrastructural, and material support, including teacher training and supervision. Since 2018, the Foundation has been operating 37 Balwadis and has refurbished 14 Anganwadis in the last two years.



















SCHOOL OF SUSTENANCE SHRIVAN WADI PROJECT

The Bhavyata Foundation has initiated the **Shrivan Wadi** project under the School of Sustenance to uplift tribal and marginalised families from poverty. This initiative aims to support 10 tribal families by providing **0.5** acres of cultivation land each, enabling them to earn a minimum annual income of Rs. 50,000.

By promoting sustainable livelihoods, the project enhances economic prospects, contributes to environmental preservation, and combats climate change. The Shrivan Wadi project embodies our commitment to fostering sustainable development and improving the quality of life for these communities.




