In Aug, Bhavyata Foundation supported to feed for livestock in Igatpuri during the extreme summer, fulfilling our commitment to community welfare. Our "Adopt an Anganwadi" projects in Ghatkopar West is completed, creating a learning-enabled environment for underprivileged children. Concurrently, The Foundation continues to impact rural Maharashtra(Palghar District) and urban Mumbai communities in early childhood education, impacting more than 268 children annually through adopted Anganwadis. Furthermore, the foundation provides access to quality education for 1583 underprivileged preschool children in BMC schools in Mumbai.

DANGI BREEDS SURVIVAL

SAMVARDHAN, through its 'Sowing the Seeds' initiative, aids gopalaks in preserving indigenous breeds amid challenges posed by limited grazing pastures and inadequate feed resources.



FEED DISTRIBUTION

Amidst the scorching summer heat and scarce resources, we've stepped in to support cows in need by distributing 0.8 tons of dry nutritional fodder.



GOPALAKS SUPPORTED

10 Gopalaks and 260 bovines benefitted, resulting in increased milk production after consuming nutritional feed. The Gopalaks then process the milk into condensed form sold in the marketplace, providing livelihoods.

Teachers Meeting

In a recent **meeting on 23rd of November 2024**, we discussed the upcoming **festivals** and planned **celebration activities** to engage students meaningfully. Emphasis was placed on **preparing lesson plans and documenting worksheets** to ensure a structured learning approach. Teachers were encouraged to teach students about **hygiene and the importance of good manners** while addressing bad manners and how to avoid them. The significance of **cleanliness** was highlighted, along with maintaining punctuality for each class. Teachers were reminded to submit photos and videos of activities promptly to enhance records and reporting. 
Preschool Education at Balwadi and Mumbai Public schools

Exams held in Preschools

Bhavyata Foundation provided exam papers to all 20 Mumbai Public Schools, covering a range of subjects to assess students' progress. These papers included sections on Language, focusing on reading, writing, and comprehension skills; Maths, to evaluate basic numeracy, such as counting, addition, and subtraction; and Critical Thinking, encouraging problem-solving and logical reasoning. Additionally, there were sections on Tracing, helping assess fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination, and Identification, which tested students' ability to recognize shapes, colours, and objects. These exam papers were designed to assess various developmental milestones in a comprehensive manner, ensuring a holistic understanding of the children's skills and abilities.














Preschool Education at Balwadi and Mumbai Public schools

PTM held in Preschool

A Parent-Teacher Meeting was held in preschool to discuss important aspects of the children's development and learning. Teachers provided an overview of the worksheets and activities completed so far, explaining how they align with the curriculum and support the students' growth. Individual progress reports for each child were shared with parents, highlighting achievements and areas for improvement. Emphasis was placed on sending healthy food in the tiffins, with suggestions for nutritious meal options to ensure the children stay energetic and focused throughout the day.
