At A Glance

In January 26, Bhavyata Foundation supported livestock feeding in Igatpuri during winter and completed its “Adopt an Anganwadi” project in Ghatkopar West, creating nurturing learning spaces. Aligned with NEP 2020, we strengthen early childhood education across Palghar and Mumbai, reaching over 300 children through adopted Anganwadis and supporting 2,100+ preschoolers in BMC schools.

Through the Shrivani Wadi Project in Wada, Palghar, we adopted 16 wadis, providing mango, mogra, cashew, lemon, and guava saplings. Our MAA initiative conducts monthly Garbh Sanskar sessions and provides nutritional kits to pregnant women.

Project Vidyavan in Kalina has planted 5,000+ native trees, while interns actively support our grassroots efforts.



DANGI BREEDS SURVIVAL

Through the Sowing the Seeds initiative, SAMVARDHAN stands with gopalaks in safeguarding indigenous breeds, even as they face declining grazing spaces and insufficient feed resources.



FEED DISTRIBUTION

Amidst the scorching summer heat and scarce resources, we've stepped in to support cows in need by distributing 0.8 tons of dry nutritional fodder.



GOPALAKS SUPPORTED

13 Gopalaks and 298 bovines benefitted, resulting in increased milk production after consuming nutritional feed. The Gopalaks then process the milk into condensed form sold in the marketplace, providing livelihoods.





Teachers Training

Teachers' Training and group discussions were conducted in January, with 33 teachers participating, focusing on academic planning and classroom practices. During these sessions, teachers' copies of ALOK Part 1 and Part 2 were distributed, and detailed discussions were held on assessment methods and examination papers. The meetings created a collaborative platform for sharing insights and strengthening teaching-learning processes.



Shrivan Wadi Project

📍 **Location: Taluk Wada, Dist. Palghar. Maharashtra**

The School of Sustenance is one of the six initiatives of the Bhavyata Foundation, promoting and propagating the principles of wellness, sustainability, and empowering livelihoods. Our Shrivan Wadi project aims to establish four orchards in Wada Taluk of Palghar District, transforming the lives of tribal families who rely on seasonal farming and daily wage labour.



Farmers: Manik Mhasara, Jagan Mhasara and Manoj Kadu

Farmers **Manik Mhasara, Jagan Mhasara, and Manoj Kadu** from Shrivan Wadi practice sustainable farming. These **tribal farmer** from Wada, **supports his family through seasonal crops and labor work for his children's education**. Together, they grow jasmine, mango, and cashew with proper irrigation and pest control, ensuring healthy crops and future yields.

Progress for Jan 26

In **January, Charan Wadi showed steady growth** across **cashew, Kesar mango, and mogra** plantations. **Mango and cashew trees displayed fresh vegetative** growth, while mogra showed early bud formation in some areas. Regular mulching, light pruning, **soil conditioning, and pest monitoring** supported plant health. Overall, the plantations remained stable and well prepared for upcoming flowering and fruiting cycles.



Shrivan Wadi Project

 **Location: Wada taluk, Palghar**

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Farmers: Devram Vatas, Kamlakar Phuphane and Balu Ghatal

Farmers Devram Vatas, Kamlakar Phuphane and Balu Ghatal from Shrivan Wadi practice sustainable farming. **These tribal farmer from Wada supports his family through seasonal crops and labor work for his children's education.**

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Farmers: Ashok Shende, Somnath Shende, Sunita Bhoje and Sainath Komb
Farmers Ashok Shende, Somnath Shende and Sunita Bhoje from Topale Pada, along with Sainath Komb from Topale Pada, practice sustainable farming methods to ensure long-term productivity and environmental balance. **With 3–4 acres of land, they cultivate rice, mogra, and lemon, selling** their produce in the local market to support their family income and fund their children’s education.

In **January 2026**, the **Miyawaki forest** at **Kalina campus, University of Mumbai** displayed remarkable progress. Many saplings have crossed **six feet**, with **several flowering richly**. Dense greenery now attracts **butterflies and birds**, **boosting campus biodiversity**. Recent rains enriched the soil, while weed control, mulching, and drip irrigation strengthened resilience. **Of the 5,000 saplings planted, survival remains high**, forming a thriving young woodland that is steadily improving soil health, moderating the microclimate, and advancing long-term ecological sustainability.





